We ask every ReMake partner to assess the commitment of each potential candidate. This ensures the very best chance of their attendance and completion of the course. The value of each place is well over £1,500 and it is therefore critical that we all work together to ensure the strongest candidates are enrolled on the course.

Course Outcomes
